Gallon of Hope

The Wednesday night 5th and 6th grade class would like to invite the congregation at NHC to participate with them in a project to minister to the homeless people in our community.

The class is hoping that people at the Chapel will donate bottled water, cotton gloves, travel size packages of wipes, travel size hand sanitizer, toothbrushes, travel size toothpaste, and breakfast protein bars. The kids will fill gallon-sized zip-lock baggies with one of each of these items along with a Gospel of John booklet. Once the baggies are packed, they will then be made available to anyone in the congregation willing to take, keep in their car, and hand out as the Lord presents opportunities. Baskets for your donations will be available in the lobby for the next 3 Sundays.

Note: None of the items to be included in the baggies would enable or encourage poor decisions, but would recognize that the recipients are made in the image of God and would honor the need for human dignity by providing help for basic hygiene, hunger and thirst (both physical and spiritual).
