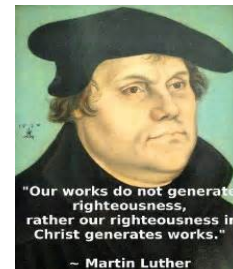

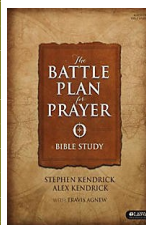
"You Are Here" Theology Conference
