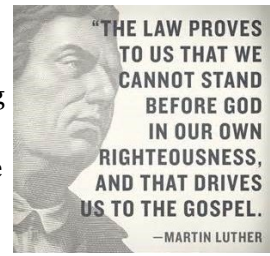

"You Are Here" Theology Conference

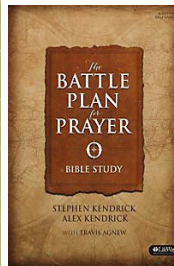
Mark your calendars for the "You Are Here"
